#### IMPORTANT TUITION INFORMATION

The Driver Education program is a self-supporting program. The cost of the program is shared by student tuition and state reimbursement. To be eligible for state reimbursement, thus receiving the listed tuition price, the student must be 15-17 years of age and have a valid Oregon permit. **If a student is 18 years old, turns 18 prior to completing the program, or obtains their license prior to completing the program, they are NOT eligible for state reimbursement and must pay the additional tuition amount of \$210.**

#### PROGRAM DETAILS

#### SCHEDULING

The schedule provided is for **class time only**, 6 behind-the-wheel lessons will be scheduled with the instructor outside of class time & **will** extend beyond the last class date.

#### REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ Students must obtain their permit prior to registration
- ✓ **PERMIT NUMBER & ISSUE DATE ARE REQUIRED AT TIME OF REGISTRATION**
- ✓ Students must have a minimum of 10 hours of driving practice prior to their first behind-the-wheel lesson
- ✓ **Students must bring a photocopy of their permit to the first class**
